Dress Code Reminders

Cold weather always brings problems with dress code. Parents, please help us by making sure your children are following the school uniform dress code. Please make sure clothes are in good condition. Make sure that skirts are the proper length. Remember bows and other decorations must be dress code colors. For safety do not let your children wear long scarves, long necklaces, or dangling hoop earrings.

Remember all clothing worn in the classroom is to be dress code appropriate. This includes being the proper color. Jackets or sweatshirts worn in the classroom are to be red, white, or blue. NKCS Spirit Sweatshirts are acceptable over uniform shirts. NKCS Spirit T-shirts are not dress code, except for Friday's designated as Spirit Shirt Days. Long sleeve shirts worn under uniform polo shirts must be red, white, or blue. Leggings worn under skirts must be red, white or blue. **Black and Gray are not dress code colors and are not acceptable for clothing in the classroom.** Black and Gray are only acceptable for socks.

No-show socks are not acceptable. Socks must cover the ankle bones. Stripes and any decoration must be dress code colors. (Gray and Black are acceptable for socks only.)

Jackets and sweatshirts worn on the playground do not have to be school colors, but if they are not school colors, they must be taken off when the student comes inside. Hats are not acceptable inside.
