### Year Book

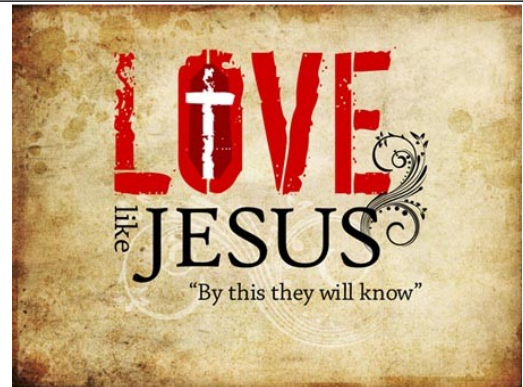
